

Special MEC Conference Call Meeting

March 4, 1999

Agenda: Interim Agreement with Shuttle

2000 Roll call: All MEC members present except Baier proxy Tosi (DiOrio)

Chair says he will ask Les Robinson, Shuttle MEC Chairman, to speak, then Joint Negotiating Committee, then ask them to leave call, then MEC will debate interim agreement.

Robinson speaks, JNC member Ken Paul speaks

Kim Snider goes through interim agreement

Motion Mayer/Tosi:

WHEREAS the US Airways MEC, the US Airways Shuttle MEC, and ALPA adopted a protocol stating that discussions between the joint negotiating committee and management were to be conducted in order to negotiate an interim agreement and

WHEREAS such discussions have led to management's proposal for an interim agreement which has been endorsed by the Joint Negotiating Committee, and

WHEREAS management's proposal offers substantial improvements in the terms and conditions of employment for Shuttle pilots

while allowing the Shuttle to be expanded utilizing US Airways pilots in conformity with market demand, and

WHEREAS in conformity with the protocol established by the MECs and ALPA, the US Airways/Shuttle interim agreement must be ratified by both the US Airways MEC and the US Airways Shuttle MEC to take effect,

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the US Airways MEC approves the US Airways/Shuttle interim agreement, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the MEC supports full parity in wage rates for all US Airways Shuttle pilots and instructs the US Airways members of the Joint Negotiating Committee to negotiate a guarantee of such parity in the negotiations for the merged employment agreement
